After keeping it close early, the Tulsa Shock fell to the Mercury in a record-setting blowout for Phoenix. With the Shock up 14-12 with 6:30 remaining in the first quarter, Phoenix went on a 10-2 run, led by Diana Taurasi's eight points, to take a 22-16 lead. Phoenix never trailed from that point on, pushing its lead to as much as 35 at 4:38 in the fourth quarter. Phoenix scored 59 points in the first half which set the new franchise mark for points in a half. Phoenix' 116 total points is a new single-game record in the WNBA. The Shock shot a mere 42.7 percent from the field and were outrebounded by 10 (42-32). Shanna Crossley led the Shock in scoring with 17 points, including five three-pointers which tied her previous season high of field goals made. For the first time all season, all 11 Shock players didn't see playing time.

A San Antonio record 22 steals in conjunction with 28 total Tulsa turnovers caused the Shock to fall, 87-75, to the Silver Stars on June 11. The loss was Tulsa's second straight and dropped the Shock to 3-5 on the season and 1-3 on the road. After holding a two-point lead at half, Tulsa's first point in the second half came at the 7:07 mark in the third quarter off a free throw from Scholonda Robinson. The Shock did not score a field goal until 6:24 in the quarter off a bucket from Kara Braxton.

During the first quarter the Shock committed 11 turnovers and the Silver Stars were unable to capitalize on any. In the second half Tulsa committed 17 turnovers off of which the Silver Stars were able to score 18 points.

The Shock were riding a two-game winning streak before traveling to Chicago and suffering its worst loss of the season, 95-70. The 25-point difference was the largest margin of victory in Sky history. Shanna Crossley was red-hot from behind the arc, shooting 5-6 on her way to a 20-point effort. Scholanda Robinson came off the bench to add 15 points, but it wasn't enough to overcome a career effort by Chicago's Sylvia Fowles, who had 32 points and 13 rebounds in the game. Tulsa never led in the game, and Chicago put it away after a 25-4 run in the fourth quarter. Rookie guard Natasha Lacy continued her run of consecutive games with at least five assists, extending that streak to six games with a team-high seven assists. The game was the first of a four-game road trip for the Shock. They have the week off before traveling to San Antonio on Friday to seek revenge on a loss to the Silver Stars earlier in the season.

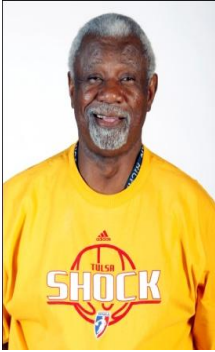

WNBA CAREER TRENDS AND NOTES

- Hired as the General Manager and Head Coach by the Tulsa Shock on October 20, 2009.
- Won first pre-season game, 90-80, over the Seattle Storm.

GENERAL CAREER NOTES

- Won a National Junior College championship in 1980 at Western Texas College
- Head coach at the University of Tulsa from 1981 to 1985, leading Tulsa to the NIT championship in 1981 and compiling a 119-37 record over five seasons.
- Became the head coach of the University of Arkansas in 1985.
- Took the University of Arkansas to the Final Four three times, losing to Duke in the semifinals in 1990, winning the National Championship in 1994 against Duke, and losing in the Championship game to UCLA in 1995.
- Named National Coach of the Year in 1994.
- His teams typically played an up tempo game with intense pressure defense – a style that was known as “40 Minutes of Hell.”
- Winningest coach in Arkansas history, compiling a 389-169
- From 2005 to 2007, Richardson served as the head coach of the Panamanian National team
- In March 2007, Richardson was named the head coach of the Mexican National Team.
